The itinerary

Day 1

Australia – Paris

Today depart from Sydney for Paris with award winning airlines such as Emirates Airlines, Etihad Airways, Lufthansa, Singapore Airlines or Cathay Pacific to name a few (subject to availability).

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 2

Welcome to Paris

Once you arrive you'll be taken to your hotel to spend the day however you like.

Overnight: Median Paris Porte de Versailles, Paris

Day 3

Paris city tour

Your tour leader will be with you the whole day so you get more from this beautiful city. View Paris highlights including the Eiffel Tower, Notre Dame, Seine River bridges, Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysees, and Place de la Concorde, plus visit the famous Saint Germain neighbourhood.

Overnight: Median Paris Porte de Versailles, Paris

Meals included: Breakfast

Day 4

Paris – Dijon City Tour – Fromagerie Gaugry

Enjoy breakfast this morning before starting the scenic journey south-east to the Burgundy region, famous for producing top quality wines. Arrive at Dijon and enjoy a panoramic tour of the city, taking in sights such as Notre Dame, the Place de la Liberation, and Cathedral to name a few. Continue to the famous Fromagerie Gaugry, where you'll enjoy a wine and cheese tour and discover why their quality products are among the best in the world.

Overnight: Hotel ibis Dijon Sud, Dijon

Day 5

Dijon – Lucerne

Today you'll travel eastbound from Dijon, passing through Mulhouse and Basel, and arrive in the city of Lucerne. On arrival enjoy a panoramic tour of the city, which lies on the shore of Lake Lucerne. Enjoy views of the world famous wooden Chapel Bridge and Water Tower, the Musegg Wall, the Jesuit Church, the Mill Bridge, the Lion Monument and the KKL culture and convention centre.

Overnight: Hotel Zum Hirschen, Lucerne

Day 6

Lucerne – Lake Lugano – Lake Como – Lomazzo

Leaving the beautiful city of Lucerne behind, continue north to Italy. En route see Lugano Lake at the Switzerland-Italy borders and the town of Lugano. This charming city offers visitors an array of restaurants and bars, plus the famous via Nassa shopping district which boasts of row upon row of boutiques and department stores. Continue to Como for a nice afternoon tour, starting from the lakefront and Piazza Cavour and continuing to Duomo, San Fedele church, the Broletto and Villa Olmo.

Lomazzo – Verona – Venice

After breakfast continue onwards to Verona for a short stop to see Juliet's Balcony, inspired by the Shakespearean tale of Romeo and Juliet, and continue to the Venice area for the night.

Day 8

Venice walking tour

Enjoy a full day in Venice, beginning with a walking tour along to the canals. Explore the cobble laneways and grand squares and you'll soon understand why this city is considered among the most romantic in the world. See famous sights including the Rialto bridge, Doge's Palace, and St Mark's Clocktower, and take a vaporetto (waterbus) down the Grand Canal.

Venice – Florence walking tour

Departing Venice, drive to the picturesque Tuscany region with its artistic heritage, and stand-out cities. Enjoy a short walking tour in Florence, viewing the Ponte Vecchio, Piazza del Duomo, and more. Enjoy the remainder of the day at your leisure.

Day 15

Palma de Mallorca, Spain

Palma is a vibrant coastal city, a world away from the heaving tourist enclaves of the surrounding bay. The obvious landmark to see in Palma is the Cathedral, which dominates the Mediterranean Sea waterfront and backs onto the oldest part of the city, a cluster of alleys and narrow lanes whose northern and eastern limits are marked by the zigzag of avenues built beside – or in place of – the city walls.

Civitavecchia Port – Rome walking tour

The cruise ends this morning, docking back in Civitavecchia. A tour representative displaying an NRMA sign will be waiting for you at the port to drive you to Rome.

This afternoon enjoy a walking tour of Rome, the Eternal City. Heading to Rome’s centre, pass the Santa Maria del Popolo Church and hear tales of how the Emperor Nero was buried near this church. Continue to the Spanish Steps, which lead elegantly down from the church of Trinita dei Monti, before taking a break by the Trevi Fountain. Continue with a stroll through Piazza Colonna, a stylish square considered by the ancient Romans as the centre of the city. Then, enjoy a photo opportunity at the world-famous Colosseum and Pantheon, a unique historic temple with sleek marble columns. Follow your guide through bustling Piazza Navona, typified by its ornate fountains, Baroque architecture and lively sidewalk cafés.

Tour Guide vs Tour Leader

Tour Guide:

Often locals with intimate knowledge of an area, its culture, and history. Their role entails providing commentary, routing the tour, and seeing that people have a good time. They are a licensed, qualified expert who supplies specific information on history, art, architecture and culture of the city/village/attraction in which he or she is guiding the tour. The guide meets the group at the required place and leaves the group at the end of the tour, they do not travel with the group.

Tour Leader:

An experienced person tasked with ensuring the smooth operation of tours, as well as providing practical support to passengers throughout the whole trip. Their role primarily includes assisting with accommodation, transportation between locations, and communication with tour guides in each stop. A tour leader may provide general guidance around a city or village, and offer information on the place visited on the bus, however they are not required to have specific knowledge on art, architecture, or history. They are not allowed to provide a guided tour or commentary of a city/village/attraction once there and if caught doing so, can be fined.

Please Note: tour leaders/guides are not a standard inclusion in all NRMA travel offers. Tour leaders/guides will only be made available when particularly required to enhance the experience of the destination featured.



Other important information

Cruise

- Disembarkation usually begins 2 hours after docking.
- Due to security reasons, all guests must be on board 2 hours before sailing.
- Itineraries are subject to change at any time without notice.
- Check your specific sailing for exact departure and arrival times. All times are local to the port.

Coach tour

Meals:

31 meals in total are included in the tour, for all other meals; lunches and dinners the tour leader (when available) will offer assistance with reservations, suggestions and directions to local restaurants whilst on the land tour. You can also enquire about any allergies and food and if necessary advise meals to be prepared with any medication you require.

Luggage:

You will be responsible for all your personal belongings whilst on the tour. With regards to luggage, you must carry your own luggage from the coach to the hotel room and back to the coach. The driver will assist with the uploading and offloading of their luggage from the coach.

Gratuities:

Gratuities (tips) are not included in the tour price for services of the tour leader (when available) and driver throughout the tour. The recommended tip for the tour leader and driver is €5 per person per day, which will be collected whilst on tour. The cruise involves a compulsory €9 per person per day payable onboard 'MSC Fantasia' ship.

Fitness level required/mobility:

Our vehicles are not equipped with wheelchair access, so unfortunately our tours are currently not suitable for wheelchair users and those less mobile.

Please note: a general level of fitness will be required. If you have any concerns please consult your healthcare provider prior to purchase/travel.

Visas

- A tourist visa is not required when travelling on an Australian passport
- Passengers who are not Australian citizens must check with the respective consulate or a visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required
