The pinch-me moments continue in Botswana, where the Chobe Princess houseboat will be waiting to take you on a two night cruise along the Chobe and Zambezi Rivers. Spot elephants, birdlife and hippos from the deck, meet Namibian village elders and learn of their fascinating cultural traditions, and discover the medicinal qualities of Africa's unique native flora. Transfer to Mpumalanga – gateway to Kruger National Park. Keep an eye out for the famed Big Five – the African lion, African elephant, Cape buffalo, African leopard, and White/Black rhinoceros. With return international flights, seven nights accommodation, a two night cruise, 16 meals, three internal flights, and professional English speaking guides, this package has it all.

The itinerary

Day 1

Australia – Johannesburg, South Africa

Today you depart from either Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide or Perth to Johannesburg, South Africa. You'll fly with either South African Airways, Singapore Airlines or Etihad Airways, to name a few (subject to availability).

Meals included: Inflight meals.

Day 2

Welcome to Johannesburg

Upon arrival in Johannesburg you'll meet your tour representative who'll arrange a transfer to your hotel.

Overnight: Peermont Mondior Hotel.

Day 3

Johannesburg – Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

Enjoy breakfast before taking the complimentary shuttle to the airport in time for your flight to Victoria Falls. There you'll be met on arrival and transferred to your accommodation.

Overnight: A'Zambezi Lodge.

Meals included: Breakfast.

Day 4

Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

Today begins with a guided tour of Victoria Falls accompanied by an English speaking guide. You'll discover how these immense falls were formed, their cultural importance and what local customs and traditions surround them. Afterwards, you'll be transferred back to your accommodation to enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight: A'Zambezi Lodge.

Meals included: Breakfast.

Day 5

Victoria Falls – Chobe – Zambezi and Chobe River cruise

After breakfast, you'll be transferred to neighbouring Botswana for your two night river cruise aboard the Chobe Princess. A representative of the ship will greet you on arrival and welcome you aboard. Spend the afternoon relaxing on board viewing the huge variety of bird and plant life, listen to the sounds of a hippo grunting and breathe in the sweet smell of African grass. After sipping on a traditional African safari sundowner, sit down to a three-course evening meal as you're serenaded to the sounds of hyenas, elephants and perhaps even lions nearby.

Overnight: Chobe Princess houseboat.

Meals included: Breakfast, dinner.

Day 6

Zambezi and Chobe River cruise

After breakfast, climb aboard one of the ship's tenders for a game drive on the water. With access to the river frontage of the Chobe National Park, these quiet boats equipped with small outboard motors offer an intimate encounter with the enormous diversity of animals on the banks of the Chobe River. You'll then travel by tender boat to a local Namibian village called Ijambwe, situated on the floodplains of the East Caprivi. There you can meet village elders and locals and gain a greater understanding of how the inhabitants of this 100 year old village live, including their daily challenges and traditions. Guests can also go on a walking tour to a 2000 year old baobab tree where you'll learn more about the medicinal and spiritual value of Impalila Island's flora. For more adventurous guests, if you have the inclination to climb the tree, you'll be rewarded with a bird's eye view of the meeting place of two rivers and four countries.

Overnight: Chobe Princess houseboat.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch, dinner.



The itinerary

Day 7

Cruise disembark – Kasane – Mpumalanga, South Africa

Enjoy onboard breakfast before transferring to Kasane where you will meet your flight to Mpumalanga, South Africa. On arrival, you'll be transferred to your accommodation, located a short drive from Kruger National Park.

Overnight: Likweti Lodge.

Meals included: Breakfast, dinner.

Day 8

Kruger National Park

This morning you'll depart the lodge and head off on your first full day game drive. Accompanied by an English speaking guide and professional rangers, keep an eye peeled for the 'Big Five'. Discover Kruger National Park and the majestic mammals that call this reserve home: lions, buffalo, giraffes, elephants and more.

Overnight: Likweti Lodge.

Meals included: Breakfast, dinner.

Day 9

Kruger National Park

Today begins with another early start, but it's well worth it. Keep your eyes peeled and cameras ready for any of the Big Five you may have missed yesterday. You'll enjoy another full day game drive in Kruger National Park before returning to the lodge in time for a few sundowners and dinner.

Overnight: Likweti Lodge.

Meals included: Breakfast, dinner.

Day 10

Kruger National Park

Today is free to be spent as you like. Enjoy some leisure time at the lodge or participate in the many available optional tours.

Day 11

Kruger National Park – Mpumalanga – Johannesburg – Australia

Enjoy your final morning in Kruger National Park before transferring to Mpumalanga airport and boarding your return flight to Australia.

Day 11

Kruger National Park – Mpumalanga – Cape Town

Enjoy your final morning in Kruger National Park before transferring to Mpumalanga airport and boarding your flight to Cape Town. Here you'll be met on arrival and transferred to your accommodation.

Overnight: Cape Town Lodge Hotel.

Meals included: Breakfast.

Day 12

Cape Town

After breakfast, you'll be collected from your hotel for a drive to view the rugged seascape of Chapman's Peak Drive, and on to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, one of the world's biodiversity hotspots, before continuing to Cape Point itself. You'll be able to view the confluence of the Indian and Atlantic Ocean currents and the treacherous promontory of rocks and swells; the scourge of mariners for centuries. You'll then stop at the Black Marlin for lunch. Finally, visit Boulders Beach and its penguin colony before returning to the city in the afternoon.

Overnight: Cape Town Lodge Hotel.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch.

Day 13

Cape Town

After breakfast, you'll be collected from your hotel and transferred to the collection point for a trip to Robben Island, the infamous prison of Nelson Mandela. After the cruise you'll travel along the scenic winelands route. Stop in at Boschendal Wine Estate for a wine tasting and buffet lunch before returning to the city in the afternoon.

Overnight: Cape Town Lodge Hotel.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch.

Day 14

Cape Town – Johannesburg – Australia

Today you'll be transferred to Cape Town Airport for your flight to Johannesburg where you'll connect with your international return flight to Australia.

Meals included: Inflight meals.

Exclusions

- Visa fees and requirements (A visa for Zimbabwe is a strict requirement if travelling on an Australian passport. Visas are not required for entry to South Africa, Botswana or Namibia).
- Meals and beverages not stated in the itinerary.
- Recommended gratuities/tipping: R 25 (approx \$3 AUD) for drivers and R 35 (approx \$4 AUD) for guides per person/day.
- Optional activities and tours.
- Personal expenses.
- Mandatory travel insurance.

Please note: A comprehensive travel insurance policy must be organised before all details can be finalised with the NRMA.

Visas

- A Single Entry visa can be purchased on arrival in Zimbabwe for \$30 USD when travelling on an Australian passport.
- Visas are not required for South Africa, Botswana and Namibia when travelling on an Australian passport.

Please note: Passengers who are not Australian citizens must check with the respective consulate or a visa agency to determine what their visa requirements are and what personal identification is required.

Schedule of fees

Voluntary changes
